From the Bridgeport Area: Take Route 8 north to Exit 31 (Route 84 to Hartford). Take Exit 22 off Route 84 (Baldwin St.). At the second light take a left onto South Main St. At the next light take a left onto Grand St. Two blocks go left on Field St. to parking garage.

From the Danbury Area: Take Exit 22 off Route 84 (Baldwin St.). At the second light take a left onto South Main St. At the next light take a left onto Grand St. Two blocks go left on Field St. to parking garage.

From The Hartford area: Take Exit 21 off Route 84. Take a sharp right at the end of the ramp onto Field St. On right is the Field St. parking garage.

From The Torrington area: Take Route 8 south to Exit 32 onto Riverside St. At light, take a left onto Freight Street. At the 2nd light, get into the middle lane then take a right on Meadow St. At first light, go left onto Grand St. then at light left on Field St. Take 2nd left onto Field St. to parking garage.
